Jungle path

Designer Sophie Walker is creating an immersive experience for visitors to Borde Hill Garden near Haywards Heath in West Sussex. Her design for the exotic Round Dell includes a arrow-shaped, gravel path that will lead to a concrete pool fed by a waterfall. The contemporary-looking path with concrete sides will give visitors the chance to explore fully the subtropical, foliage-rich planting, which will become denser and more jungly as the path narrows, and will include species collected by Bleddyn and Sue Wynn-Jones of Crûg Farm Plants. bordehill.co.uk
